**DNR LAND ACQUISITION**

Mr. Craig Soupir, Minnesota Department of Natural Resources presented the following item to the Board:

Review of Proposed State Land Acquisition**

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 84.944, Subd. 3 and 97A.145, Subd. 2, the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources on April 4, 2023 provided the county board with a description of lands to be acquired by the State of Minnesota for water, wildlife conservation and public access purposes.

Lands to be acquired are described as follows:

*Commencing at the northwest corner of said Government Lot 1; thence on a bearing based on the 1983 Blue Earth County Coordinate System (1996 Adjustment), of North 89 degrees 40 minutes 44 seconds East, 1025.55 feet along the north line of said Government Lot 1 to a ¾ inch by 24 inch rebar with a plastic cap stamped “MN DNR LS 17003” (DNR MON) and the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 02 degrees 55 minutes 39 seconds East, 772.89 feet to a DNR MON; thence South 59 degrees 31 minutes 38 seconds East, 170.79 feet to a DNR MON; thence South 79 degrees 44 minutes 14 seconds East, 151.83 feet to a DNR MON; thence South 01 degree 22 minutes 15 seconds East, 184.31 feet to a DNR MON; thence South 73 degrees 47 minutes 32 seconds East, 165.07 feet to a DNR MON; thence continuing South 73 degrees 47 minutes 32 seconds East, 10 feet, more or less, to the water’s edge of Ida Lake and there terminating.*

*Containing 8.32 acres more or less.*

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Blue Earth County on April 4, 2023 that the State’s proposed acquisition of the attached described property be approved.

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The Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners, sitting as the drainage authority for Blue Earth County Ditch 79, having received a Petition for Improvements to Blue Earth County Ditch 79 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 103E.215, having noticed and conducted a public hearing on the Preliminary Survey Report, and based on the record and proceedings, it was moved, and seconded to adopt the following Findings and Order:

**Findings:**

1. Blue Earth County utilizes a County Administrator organizational plan. The Blue Earth County Administrator has assumed the powers and duties assigned to the auditor under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 103E.
2. A Petition dated September 19, 2022 and Surety Bond in the amount of \$50,000 was received by the Blue Earth County Property and Environmental Resources Department requesting to Establish an Improvement to Blue Earth County Ditch 79, located in Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Judson Township in Blue Earth County., Minnesota pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103E.215
3. The drainage authority met on October 11, 2022 and accepted the Petition. The drainage authority also appointed Charles J. Brandel, PE, of ISG Inc., to make a Preliminary Survey Report, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103E.245.
4. Engineer Charles J. Brandel filed a Preliminary Survey Report with the drainage authority on February 6, 2023. A copy of the Preliminary Survey Report Preliminary Survey Report was mailed to the Director of the Division of Ecological and Water Resources in the Department of Natural Resources on February 7, 2023.
5. The drainage authority, by order, set a public hearing for review of the engineer’s Preliminary Survey Report on March 7, 2023 and directed Blue Earth County Property and Environmental Resources Department to provide at least 10 days advance notice, by mail, of the time and location of the hearing to the petitioners, political subdivisions, and owners of property likely to be affected by the proposed project.
6. Notice of the public hearing was properly provided as required by law.
7. At the public hearing, the engineer presented the Preliminary Survey Report.

8. The Commissioner's Advisory Report on the preliminary plan was publicly read and included in the record of proceedings.
9. Public comment time was given during the proceedings.
10. The proposed drainage project outlined in the petition and recommended by the engineer is feasible.
11. There is necessity for the proposed drainage project.
12. The engineer has considered the environmental, land use, and multipurpose water management criteria in Minn. Stat. § 103E.015, subd. 1. Multipurpose water management and other best management practices were included in the Preliminary Survey Report.
13. After consideration of the environmental, land use, and multipurpose water management criteria in Minn. Stat. § 103E.015, subd. 1, the drainage authority finds that the proposed drainage project is of public benefit and promote the public health.
14. The outlet for the proposed drainage project is adequate.

**Order:**

Based on the foregoing Findings and the entire record of proceedings before the Board, the Blue Earth County Board, acting as the drainage authority for Blue Earth County Ditch 79, hereby orders as follows:

1. That the Preliminary Survey Report is approved.
2. The project engineer shall proceed to make a Detailed Survey Report with plans and specifications for the proposed project consistent with the findings herein and submit a Detailed Survey Report to the drainage authority as soon as possible.
3. After the Detailed Survey Report is complete, the engineer shall file the Detailed Survey Report with the Blue Earth County Property and Environmental Resources Department, Drainage staff, staff shall deliver a copy of the Detailed Survey Report to the Commissioner of Natural Resources.
4. That Mark Behrends, Robert Hansen, Kendall Langseth, John Thompson, Bruce Ness and Wes Dahl are hereby appointed as viewers to determine the benefits and damages to all property affected by the proposed drainage project and make a viewers' report.
5. The viewers shall subscribe to an oath to faithfully perform their duties. If an appointed viewer does not qualify for any reason, the auditor shall designate another qualified person to take the disqualified viewer's place.

6. That Charles J. Brandel, PE, with ISG, be appointed to aid the viewers and provide engineering services to support the viewers Benefits and Damages Report.

After discussion, the Board Chair called the question. Upon vote, the Chair declared the motion passed and the Findings and Order adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator and/or the County Property and Environmental Resources Director to execute any agreement(s) to construct the liner system and associated site or infrastructure project(s) at the Ponderosa Landfill as indicated in the engineering plans.

**WHEREAS**, an available, undeveloped parcel of approximately 67.40 acres of real estate, located at the northeast corner of CSAH 16 and CSAH 90 in Mankato Township (parcel ID: R43.09.31.300.001) has been identified.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, The Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners authorizes the acquisition of the property identified as Parcel ID R43.09.31.300.001 and delegates its authority to the Blue Earth County Administrator to negotiate and execute a Real Estate Purchase Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.00 plus reasonable fees; provided, however, that this Resolution does not constitute such an agreement and no agreement shall be created until executed by the Blue Earth County Administrator.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, Upon completion of the due diligence period and satisfaction of all conditions, waivers and contingencies set forth in the Real Estate Purchase Agreement, the Blue Earth County Administrator will request final approval from the County Board prior to the closing of the above-described property.
