4. That the applicant obtains a Blue Earth County Construction Permit before building begins and within one (1) year from the date the County Board of Commissioners approves the Conditional Use Permit. The permit shall be rendered invalid if application for a Construction Permit is not made within this one (1) year period. Time extensions for Conditional Use Permits must be obtained from the County Board of Commissioners subsequent to a public hearing conducted by the Planning Commission.
5. If required by the Department of Natural Resources, the applicant shall obtain a DNR "Water Appropriations Permit" before any animals are placed in the barn.
6. That a perimeter footing drain tile be located at or below the bottom of the pit footings. The footing tile shall include one inspection pipe for each concrete pit. The native materials must be excavated and walls back filled with granular material (pit run gravel or equivalent). *Exceptions to this may only include specific design standards submitted by the design engineer of the manure storage structure.*

Records of manure application shall be maintained as required by the MPCA. Manure application setback standards for the fields on which the manure is applied shall be followed as required by the MPCA and the County.

8. That the disposal of livestock mortality be consistent with the Minnesota Board of Animal Health regulations, and when rendering is used as a mortality disposal the applicant shall provide an enclosed location for the pick-up.
9. That adequate measures be taken to minimize or control offensive odor, fumes, dust, noise, or vibrations so that none of these will constitute a nuisance.
10. That all manure storage structures must be designed by a registered engineer.
11. That the applicant will furnish the final construction report to Environmental Services verifying that the concrete manure storage structure was constructed per approved engineered design plan within 60 days of completion of any new or modified manure storage area. Said construction report shall be signed by the design engineer.
12. That the applicant complies with the storm-water control requirements established by the MPCA.
13. That all exposed earthen surfaces be seeded into grass or utilized as crop acreage.

DIVISION 6 SECTION 2.04 THROUGH 2.05 UPDATING WHEN A COMPLIANCE  
INSPECTION IS REQUIRED FOR AN EXISTING SUBSURFACE SEWAGE  
TREATMENT SYSTEM (SSTS) ON A PARCEL.**

**WHEREAS**, Blue Earth County has a current Ordinance for Subsurface Sewage Treatment Systems (SSTS) that has been in place with revisions since 1967 and the current version stems from adoption of Minnesota Rule Chapter 7080-7081 in 2010, and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statue 115.55 establishes that all counties must adopt ordinances that apply to all areas of the County other than properties serviced by municipal sewer or Townships or Cities that facilitate a SSTS program as stringent as the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance meets the requirements for local ordinances as specified by MN Rules 7082; and

**WHEREAS**, many areas of the County are served by subsurface sewage treatment systems; and

**WHEREAS**, this revision allows for the issuance of construction permits after specific requirements are met, and

**WHEREAS**, minor changes in text are needed to stay current with MN Rule 7080-7082 amended in 2011, and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of this revision to the Ordinance has been submitted, as required, to the commissioner of the MPCA for review 30 days prior to this resolution and has been reviewed, amended and approved; and

**WHEREAS**, all Townships and Cities in the County were notified of the changes; and

**WHEREAS**, this revision is consistent with the 2008-2013 Blue Earth County Water Management Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners on the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of March, 2013, following proper notice, held a public hearing regarding the request and following consideration



of testimony, voted to approve the revision amending Division 6 section 2.04-2.05 of the Blue Earth County Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) Ordinance Chapter 6 Article V; and

**WHEREAS**, the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners finds the basic purpose of this article of the environmental section of the County Code of Ordinance is to protect the health, safety and resources available to the public.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners that the Ordinance titled Blue Earth County Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) Ordinance Chapter 6 Article V dated March 2, 2010 is hereby amended and adopted into the County Code of Ordinances.

This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its passage and publication.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**

Commissioner Bruender moved and Commissioner Stuehrenberg seconded the motion to approve the following resolution:

### **RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERIM TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE STANDARDS FOR THE TRI LAKES AREA OF THE LAKE WASHINGTON SANITARY DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS:** Blue Earth County, in accordance with, M.S. 115.55 has enacted a Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) Ordinance which delineates the County's authority and responsibilities for the administration and enforcement of these requirements for the protection of the health and safety of the public. And that this ordinance further provides for the granting of variances from these requirements; and

**WHEREAS;** Blue Earth County has recognized that some densely populated areas have physical limitations which preclude the continued long term utilization of on-site sewage systems to provide adequate sewage treatment and the construction of a collection system for off-site treatment is a desirable long term solution for these areas; and

**WHEREAS:** many of the lots within the area of annexation have a high density of residential homes and seasonal cabins, and

**WHEREAS:** many lake lots are small, have been utilized for on-site sewage treatment for many years, and are unsuitable for construction of complying on-site sewage treatment systems demanded by current standards, and

**WHEREAS:** the shoreland areas of Lake Ballantyne, Duck Lake and Madison Lake, lying within Jamestown Township and LeRay Township have been listed under Commissioners Orders by the Commissioner of the MPCA to annex into the Lake Washington Sanitary Sewer District under authority of M.S. 115.20, as defined in the State Register Volume 37, Number 21, Pages 787-796, pursuant to the findings thereunto, and

**WHEREAS:** Lake Washington Sanitary District has proposed constructing a collector sanitary sewer system, regionalized with the City of Mankato for treatment of sewage for the residents located within the shoreland areas of Lake Ballantyne, Duck Lake and Madison Lake, lying within Jamestown Township and LeRay Township, and

**WHEREAS:** The construction of the forcemain pipe servicing the City of Madison lake and as petitioned, was oversized specifically for the connection of the collector sanitary sewer for this project has been installed, and

**WHEREAS:** Blue Earth County finds that it would be counterproductive to require strict adherence to all the requirements of the SSTS Ordinance as long as there will not be an adverse impact the health, safety and welfare of the public in the short term, and

**WHEREAS:** The compliance status by inspection of the septic systems will still be required for property transfer and building permits to determine the potential impact to public health and safety, and

**WHEREAS:** Blue Earth County has previously established interim technical and administrative standards in areas of planned sewer extension; now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners directs the Environmental Services Department staff to administer and enforce the SSTS Ordinance in accordance with the Interim SSTS Standards of this resolution and the Blue Earth County Interim Technical and Administrative Policy Standards for Areas to Receive Municipal Sewer adopted by the Board and made part of this resolution, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners directs the Environmental Services Department staff to waive the requirement for upgrade for “failing to protect groundwater” systems and authorizes the staff to approve the utilization of holding tanks to mitigate imminent public health threat situations in order to protect the health and safety of the public until connection to sanitary sewer can be accomplished and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be rescinded December 31, 2016 or upon discovery that the extension of sanitary sewer will not be constructed as planned to any specified parcels in this resolution. If rescinded, all specified properties will be required to have to a code compliant system in place within 180 days of said finding unless an extension is passed by a new resolution by the County Board.

## **HUMAN SERVICES**

Mr. Phil Claussen, Human Services Director, and Mr. Jay Walters, Human Services Advisory Committee, presented the following items to the Board.

Commissioner Piepho moved and Commissioner Purvis seconded the motion to approve the following Human Services items:

Sibley County Public Health and Human Services: An agreement with Sibley County Public Health and Human Services. This agreement will allow Blue Earth County to utilize a .5 FTE (20 hours per week) of Sibley County's full-time State Registered Nurse position. The term of the agreement is from April 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014.

United Behavioral Health: An agreement with United Behavioral Health to provide health and administrative interventions to beneficiaries of the TRICARE Program. This agreement is effective April 1, 2013.

Minnesota Help Network: A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to be able to access the web-based communication tool called "REVATION." The REVATION tool helps to better coordinate services for seniors and disabled individuals. The MOU will be in effect once it is signed by both entities.

City of Mankato Department of Public Safety – Community-Based Intervention: A contract with the City of Mankato Department of Public Safety to provide community-based interventions for people being held by law enforcement personnel due to their intoxication. The term of the contract is January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.

City of Mankato Department of Public Safety – Detox Transportation: A contract with the City of Mankato Department of Public Safety to provide backup detox transportation services. The term of the contract is January 1, 2013, through December 31, 2013.

Whereas, portions of the project are within the municipal limits of Mankato and Eagle Lake, and

Whereas, cost sharing agreements have been negotiated with both Cities for reconstruction of the road within their municipal limits,

Now, therefore, be it resolved, the Chair and Administrator are authorized to execute the agreements.
