Commissioner Stuehrenberg moved and Commissioner Purvis seconded the motion to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION GRANTING A REQUEST FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO CONVERT AN EXISTING SWINE FARROW TO FINISH OPERATION OVER TO FINISHING SWINE ONLY. NO NEW CONSTRUCTION IS PURPOSED. THE PROPOSAL WILL INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ANIMAL UNITS FROM 820 TO 1,080. THE PROPERTY IS ZONED AGRICULTURAL AND IS LOCATED IN THE NORTH ½ OF THE SW ¼ OF SECTION 27, LYRA TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Ivan and Donna Borchardt, owners of the following real estate in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, to wit:

The North Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 27, Lyra Township (T-106-N, R-27-W).

WHEREAS, the Planning Agency of the County has completed a review of the application and made a report pertaining to said request (PC 15-12), a copy of said report has been presented to the Planning Commission; and,

WHEREAS; the Planning Commission of the County on the 2nd Day of May, 2012, following proper notice held a public hearing regarding the request, and following due consideration of presented testimony and information, voted unanimously to forward the matter to the County Board with a recommendation for approval subject to conditions contained in staff report PC 15-12, and,

WHEREAS; the County Board on the 22nd day of May, 2012, held a public hearing regarding the request, and following due consideration of presented testimony and information, voted unanimously to approve the request subject to conditions included in staff report PC 15-12, and,

WHEREAS, the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners finds:

1. That the proposed use conforms with the county land use plan.
2. The demonstrated need for the proposed use.
3. That the proposed use will not degrade the water quality of the county.
4. That the proposed use will not adversely increase the quantity of water runoff.
5. That soil conditions are adequate to accommodate the proposed use.
6. That the proposed use does not create a potential pollution hazard.

7. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and other necessary facilities have been or are being provided.

8. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide sufficient off-street parking and loading space to serve the proposed use.

9. That facilities are provided to eliminate any traffic congestion or traffic hazard which may result from the proposed use.

10. That the conditional use will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted.

11. That the establishment of the conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding vacant property for predominant uses in the area.

12. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to prevent or control offensive odor, fumes, dust, noise and vibration, so that none of these will constitute a nuisance, and to control lighted signs and other lights in such a manner that no disturbance to neighboring properties will result.

NA13. That the density of proposed residential development is not greater than the density of the surrounding neighborhood or not greater than the density indicated by the applicable zoning district.

14. That site specific conditions and such other conditions are established as required for the protection of the public's health, safety, morals and general welfare.

NA15. That the intensity of the proposed residential development is not greater than the intensity allowed in the Agricultural Zoning District. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Blue Earth County Board of Commissioners, that the request for a conditional use permit to convert an existing swine farrow to finish operation over to finishing swine only. No new construction is proposed. The proposal will increase the number of animal units from 820 to 1,080 is **granted** with the following conditions:

Records of manure application shall be maintained as required by the MPCA. Manure application setback standards for the fields on which the manure is applied shall be followed as required by the MPCA and the County.
6. That the disposal of dead animals be consistent with the Minnesota Board of Animal Health regulations, and when rendering is used as a mortality disposal the applicant shall provide an enclosed location for the pick-up.
7. That adequate measures be taken to minimize or control offensive odor, fumes, dust, noise, or vibrations so that none of these will constitute a nuisance.
8. That all manure storage structures must be designed by a registered engineer.
9. That the applicant complies with the storm-water control requirements established by the MPCA.
10. If shower, restroom, culinary and/or laundry facilities are to be included with the proposal, that wastewater handling practices are designed and constructed according to state requirements.
11. When the hallway barn is no longer used to house swine or manure storage the manure storage structure must be properly abandon.
