An agreement with House of Hope is for the provision of Board-and-Lodge (Rate I) services up to five individuals at their 1401 Third Avenue facility in Mankato. The term of the contract is from January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2017.

#### Horizon Homes, Inc.

An agreement with Horizon Homes provides Board-and-Lodge services (Rate II) for up to nine individuals and Board-and-Lodge (Rate I) services for up to one individual at their 306 Byron Street facility in Mankato. The term of the contract is from January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2017.

#### <u>Horizon Homes – House 8</u>

#### Morris Electronics, Inc.

#### Southwest Minnesota Housing Partnership

A contract is for Blue Earth County on behalf of SCCBI to contract with Southwest Minnesota Housing Partnership to provide residential subsidy for six scattered-site supportive housing units, and administration of the Supportive Housing Program.
