

OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED:

TEXTILES

- Accepted in a drop box at the 24-hour facility.
Items Include: clothing – shoes – belts
purses -- bags

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR A FEE:

- Electronics
- Automotive Batteries
- Tires
- Pallets
- Major Appliances

APPLIANCES

Washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, water heaters, garbage disposals, trash compactors, ranges and stoves, microwaves, dishwashers, furnaces and heat pumps, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, & conventional ovens.

ELECTRONICS

- Household televisions and computer monitors MUST be recycled.
- All business electronics must be recycled.



24-hour drop-off is for residential recycling only. Commercial recycling is welcome at the drive-thru facility free of charge.



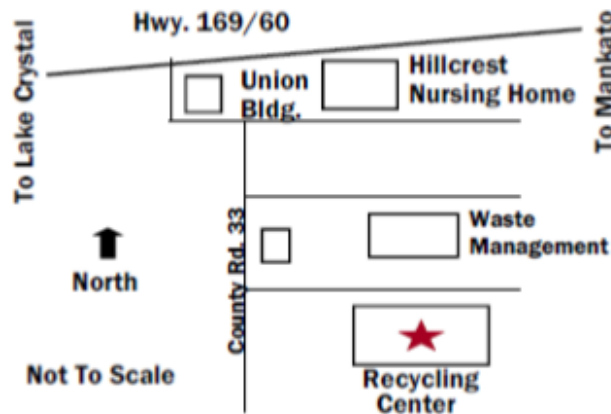

PLEASE:

- Empty and rinse all containers
 - Flatten cardboard and boxboard
 - Leave the caps on plastic bottles
- *If you remove the cap, they fall out of the recycling process and are swept into the trash.

Note: these guidelines apply to all recyclables taken to the Blue Earth County Recycling Center.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

- NO plastic wrap, bags, or films
- NO styrofoam cups, containers, or packaging
- NO ceramics, pyrex, auto or window glass, light bulbs, or drinking glasses
 - Take light bulbs to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility
- NO sparkly or metallic wrapping paper, black/dark colored paper, tissue paper, or “release” paper from stickers
- NO shredded paper (it gets loose in the sorting facility and contaminates other commodities)
- NO paper towel or toilet paper tubes & egg cartons (due to amount of glue)
- NO nesting of materials with unlike materials (ie. cans inside a cereal box)
- NO TANGLERS– strings of lights, hoses, wires

DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES

Keep loose plastic bags and bagged recyclables out of your recycling.

GLASS

Only glass bottles & jars are recyclable. Clear, blue, green and brown colored glasses are accepted at the 24-hour drop off.

PLASTICS

The recycling center accepts plastics #1, 2, & 5:
#1 PET– beverage, food, & cleaning product containers
#2 HDPE– milk jugs, detergent, & juice bottles
#5 PP– yogurt cups & margarine tubs



METAL

All metal cans (steel, tin, bi-metal, & aluminum) are accepted at the 24-hour drop-off.
